Surf Lifeguard Award 2018-19 Information

Thank you for your interest in the Surf Lifeguard Award at Papamoa Surf Lifesaving Club. Please find all course related information below. If you have any questions or concerns, don't hesitate to get in contact with an instructor.

Surf Life Saving offers a range of activities in a great environment. As a member of a club you are entitled to use the clubs facilities and appropriate equipment. Surf Life Saving also offers a range of awards, training and courses to increase your skills and knowledge.

There are so many ways to upskill after getting your Surf Life Guard Award! You can get involved in first aid, IRB crewman and drivers, patrol captains, instructors, examiners, lifeguard schools, as well as Surf Sports.

Our course requires that you attend the training sessions and put in additional study time at home to familiarise yourself with the content of the workbook. This is required to pass the practical and theory exam components. Attending a couple of lessons is not enough.

Each candidate will be assessed and signed-off prior to their chosen exam date to determine whether you are ready to sit and pass the exam. You will be tested on areas of the workbook, and if an instructor thinks you are not ready, then you will need to put in extra hours at home and sit the exam at a later date.

The reason this is in place is to ensure you pass on your first attempt. As instructors we are accountable, and it is our duty ensure you are ready to sit the exam. We will not send unprepared candidates to an exam.

Please note candidates must be at least 14 years old on exam day to sit their exam. If you are 13 and your birthday falls within this season, you can start training now and sit an exam after you turn 14.

We will be attending 3 exam dates this season and will arrange training leading up to each exam. Please pick an exam date that suits you and let your instructor know.

You are expected to attend all (or as many as you possibly can) training sessions in order to pass your Surf Lifeguard Award. If you, for example want to do exam 3, you can still attend training sessions for exam 1 or exam 2; the more you attend, the better!

Training sessions will consist of theory and practical work. You must bring your training manual and workbooks to each session, which will be signed off as we complete each section. Swimming gear is required as we will be going into the ocean. Make sure you have warm clothes to change into!

Registration and Getting Started

Please register with Surf Lifesaving New Zealand to receive an ID number to identify you in the SLSNZ system.

Exam Components

- Candidate workbook filled out and signed-off by the instructor (entry ticket to the exam)
- Pool test (400m swim in under 9 minutes, releases and tows, tube rescue)
- Theory paper (50 question written exam)
- Practical test (run-swim-run, tube rescue, CPR, first aid, radios and signals)

Exam dates

Surf Lifesaving Eastern Region set the dates for the exams over the season. These are the exam dates that Papamoa will be attending;

- Exam #1 Saturday November 10th 2018
- Exam #2 Saturday December 1st 2018
- Exam #3 Sunday February 24th 2019

You can attend any of the training sessions and pick the exam date that best works for you.

Course Expectations

You must be able to swim 400m in under 9 minutes, without stopping. Please start swimming now if you are not regularly in the pool, you should be in the pool 2-3 times a week if you don't belong to a swim squad.

Candidates will be handed a training manual and candidate workbook which you need to read and fill out. Workbooks must be filled out prior to the training sessions starting. They have to be signed-off, and serve as your entry to the exam.

Instructors will teach you about Surf Lifesaving policies, code of conduct, beach environment, wave types, rips, tube rescue and patient care, first aid, CPR, radios and signals, run-swim-runs in the ocean.
